Civic Awareness: activities addressing issues of public concern. Citizens acting alone or together to protect public values or make a change or difference in the community are common types of civic awareness.

Social Awareness: activities that allow us to take the perspective of and empathize with others from diverse backgrounds and cultures, to understand social and ethical norms for behavior, and to recognize family, school, and community resources and supports.

Leadership Development: activities that improve the skills, abilities and confidence of leaders.

Career Development: activities that increase your understanding of particular career fields, building relationships with local employers, gaining employability skills, etc.

Community Service: non-paying activities performed by one person or a group of people for the benefit of their community or its institutions
