What is a Gallery Walk?

A “Gallery Walk” is an activity that allows students to discuss and display their final work around a room much like artists would display their artistic pieces in an “exhibit.” It is a way that students can share their projects in a non-threatening way with the assurance of getting some feedback from their peers.

Our Campaign Poster Gallery Walk

We will be doing a gallery walk of campaign posters. You will be picking at least 5 posters to give feedback to. You will provide the following feedback on a sticky note and stick it around the posters of your choice:

- I like: What do you like about the campaign poster?
 - Ex: “I like the graphics that you used! They really grabbed my attention!”
- I wish: What do you wish the creator did differently? Here is your opportunity to provide constructive feedback.
 - Ex: “I wish you made the text a little bigger - it’s hard to read.”
- I wonder: What are you curious about? Here is your opportunity to ask questions to the creator.
 - Ex: “I wonder, if you get elected as President, could we take a field trip to the local courthouse?”
